## What to bring for FAFSA (students & parents/guardians):

- Social Security Number & Name on Cards
- Records of income (Student & Parent/Guardian for 2018
  - Many applicants will be able to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to populate income questions, however, bring IRS 1040 forms and W2s in case.
  - Information about assets (savings, stocks, investments), if applicable
- Driver's license number(s)
- Dates of birth (month, date year)
- Month and year of marriage, separation, divorce or other change in marital status
- Non-citizen students and parents should bring alien registration number, if available
- List of colleges you are interested in attending after high school
- A cell phone that can receive text messages and access to an email account
